to school.





We saw the joy in the eyes of our pupils when they saw these devices for the first time :) Thank you very much!












Thanks for parents

That is why ...


...we invite you to join us in making pierogi with your child at EMS:)

Everyone will have the opportunity to actively participate in the process of making pierogi, and at the end they will take them home.






For the workshop, registration is required on the EMS sign up list by 8th December.

Annual collection for the "Zakatek" children's home

This year, the children's home is asking for:

flip-flops (as for the pool):

In front of the entrance to the school there is a shelf where you will find English vocabulary for each class - these are copies for you and the children to practice, for example, in the car.

We would like to remind you that each week pupils of the second and third grades take a test on the vocabulary that is used in the following week's conversation. Eight (out of ten) correctly written vocabulary words indicate mastery of the vocabulary of the topic. The child checks the correctness of the notation with the control card.

We have a go at the test until we get it right!


a pedagogue recommends...
